Position Summary

Irrigation Technician assist the Golf Course Superintendent to maintain optimal condition and appearance of golf course turf and planter areas. This position is responsible for the installation and maintenance of irrigation systems. The selected candidate will be overseen by the Golf Course Superintendent of the Woods Valley Golf Course. This position requires regular physical labor outdoors in a variety of weather conditions.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist Superintendent with preventative maintenance of designated irrigation system.
- Repair irrigation system defects.
- Assist Superintendent in maintaining parts inventory.
- Make all irrigation orders with approval.
- Perform preventative maintenance and curative maintenance on pump stations. Operate main pumps and pump controllers.
- Record changes in irrigation system component routings or locations on the as built drawings.
- Train maintenance staff in irrigation processes.
- Assist in reading water meters and documenting water use.
- Sets all irrigation clocks for watering schedules as directed by the superintendent and as required to accommodate various activities such as mowing and pesticide applications.
- Adjusts sprinklers and watering schedules following water management practices that will most efficiently meet the individual requirements of the turf and landscape areas.
- Assist in construction or revision of sprinkler and drainage systems.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education, Experience, Qualifications and Skills:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Experience with sprinkler and drainage systems highly preferred
- Knowledge and principles of electric hydraulic, pipe and fittings pup stations and recork keeping.
- Understanding of agronomy, turf science and rules of golf
- Lifting and moving up to 50 lbs.
- Knowledge of tools
- Ability to operate light motorized equipment
- Bend, stoop, lift, and stand for long periods of time.

- 3+ year's golf course maintenance experience.
