DURO ROAD REALIGNMENT PROJECT WITHIN THE SAN PASQUAL INDIAN RESERVATION, CALIFORNIA

Notice is hereby given that the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), Southern California Agency, has released an Environmental Assessment (EA) dated October 18, 2019, for the San Pasqual Band of Diegueno Mission Indians Duro Road Realignment Project (DRAP). The DRAP EA has been prepared pursuant to the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA, 42 United States Code §4321 et seq.) and 59 IAM 3-H. The DRAP EA assesses the environmental impacts of authorizing a roadway realignment construction project on the San Pasqual Indian Reservation.

Based on the analysis and impacts detailed in the DRAP EA and any comments received during the public review period; BIA will decide whether to issue a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) determination, direct further work on the DRAP EA, or initiate the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement.

The public review period for the DRAP EA will be open for three (3) calendar days, beginning on October 23, 2019 and ending on October 25, 2019.
