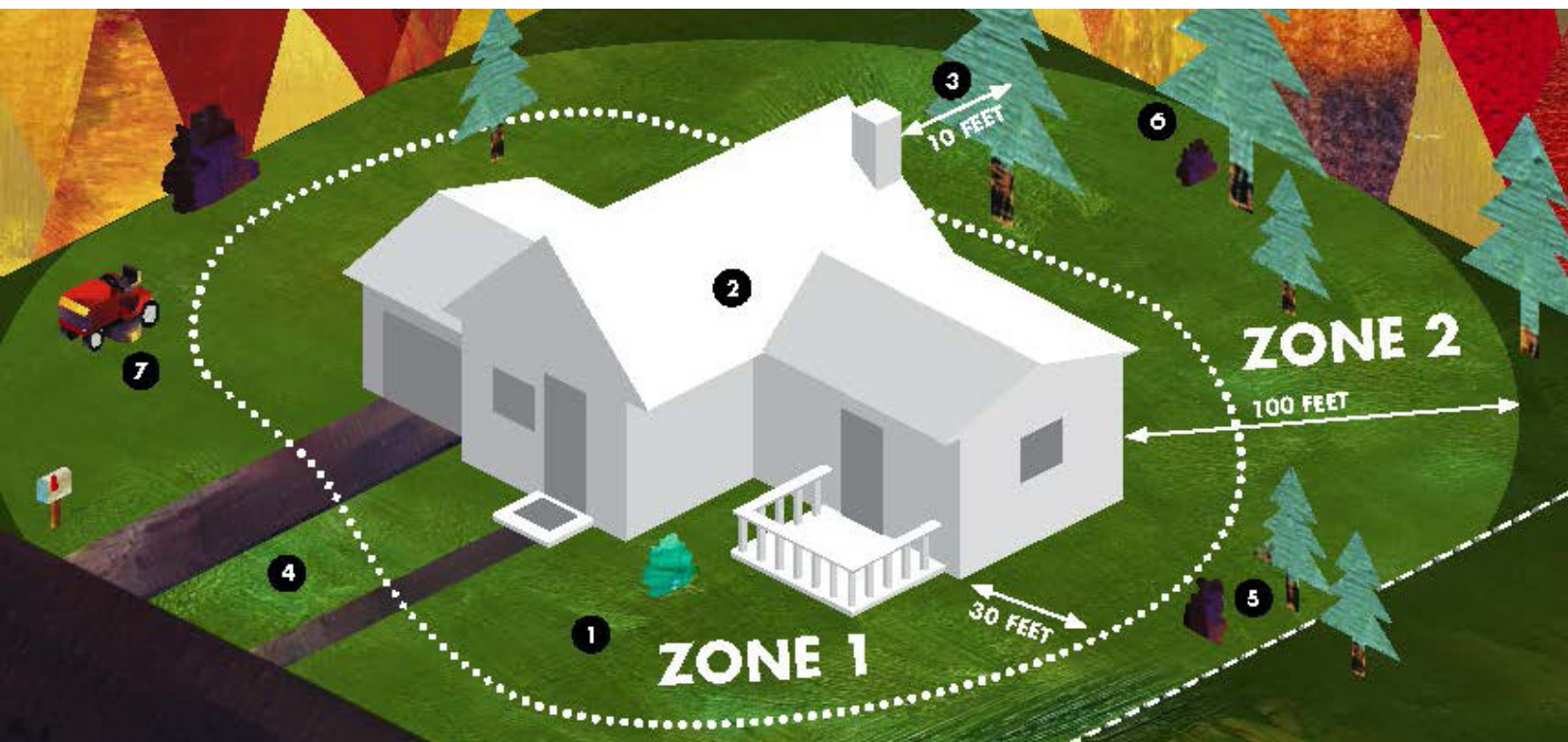


WILDFIRE IS COMING. ARE YOU READY?

Despite all of the rain we have received this past year California is still at high risk for wildfires, in fact we are more at risk than previous years. More rain means more vegetation growth and the hot dry summer means more dried out vegetation. To help prevent the spread of fire prepare your home with defensible space. Check out www.readyforwildfire.org for information on creating defensible space, preparing your family, creating wildfire action plan and creating an emergency supply kit. You can also download the CAL FIRE app from the App Store or Google Play.

The CAL FIRE app features include:

- Checklists with steps for:
 - Taking charge of your Defensible Space
 - Hardening your home
 - Creating an evacuation and family communication plan
 - Assembling an emergency supply kit
 - Evacuating early!
- Customized Wildfire Texts or Push Notifications
 - Get alerts when a wildfire is reported in your chosen zip code or within 30 miles of you.
- Fire Incidents Page, stay updated about current wildfires, such as size and containment percentage
- Fire Map, See a map of all current fires
- How to Sign-up for Wildfire Alerts
