The San Pasqual Economic Development Corporation (SPEDC) operates the Woods Valley Golf Club along with seeking other economic development opportunities to build sustainable self-sufficiency.

SPEDC is recruiting for a Travel Plaza Manager to manage the enterprises and operations of the Travel Plaza project currently underway. The successful candidate will work closely with the Economic Development Director to coordinate alignment of sales and profitability standards, and will be responsible for the development of exceptional customer service culture for the travel plaza.
