Indigenous to Southern California, the Kumeyaay-Ipai Band returned to settle in what is now San Diego and Imperial counties. The San Pasqual Economic Development Corporation (SPEDC) operates the Woods Valley Golf Club along with seeking other economic development opportunities to build sustainable self-sufficiency.

SPEDC is seeking an HR Generalist to consult for the enterprises and operations of the corporation. The successful candidate will work closely with the SPEDC enterprises to coordinate Human Resources objectives such as employee benefits, employee relations, classification/compensation and recruiting. The Generalist will be responsible for providing subject matter expertise for all Human Resources issues and activities.

The successful candidate for this position would have five (5) years of human resources experience in multiple functional specialty areas (recruiting, benefits, etc.) and performance management experience. Working within a complex organization, and providing professional development and training to a diverse workforce. Experience with tribal communities, retail and service experience preferred.
