## Responsibilities:

- **Food Prep Work**: Washing, peeling, chopping, and slicing ingredients such as vegetables, cheese, and meats to ensure they are ready for cooking.
- **Cooking Assistance**: Assisting with basic cooking tasks, such as mixing ingredients, preparing sauces, or assembling dishes. Assist with cooking food for other concepts.
- Assemble: Pizzas and chicken meals according to recipes and portion guidelines.
- **Food Storage**: Properly storing perishable and non-perishable items to maintain freshness and meet safety standards.
- **Cleaning Duties**: Washing dishes, sanitizing prep areas, sweeping, mopping, and maintaining overall kitchen cleanliness.
- **Compliance**: Following health and food safety guidelines to meet restaurant standards and following personal safety.

## **Customer Service:**

- Acknowledges, engages, and interacts with guests and other team members; anticipates and exceeds guests' needs
- Processes orders accurately by using the point-of-sale system
- Receives cash and credit card payments and issues receipts or change to guests, responsible for overages and shortages, accuracy, and security
- Addresses guest needs and concerns as they relate to order preparation and payment processing

- Must have access to adequate transportation to and from the job site

- Must be available and willing to work a variety of days/times, including weekends, evenings, and holidays.
